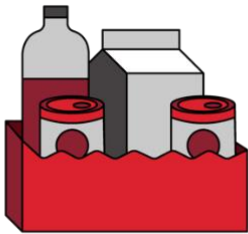

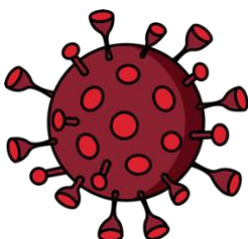
Help Us Win the Schools of the SEC Food Fight!
